## National Service Scheme (NSS) Wings समाज सेवा से व्यक्तित्व निर्माण की सशक्त पहल

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना (NSS) विद्यार्थियों के सर्वांगीण विकास के लिए एक अत्यंत महत्वपूर्ण योजना है जो आज लगभग प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय में संचालित की जा रही है। “समाज सेवा के माध्यम से व्यक्तित्व का विकास इस योजना का मूल उद्देश्य है। वास्तव में NSS केवल एक गतिविधि नहीं बल्कि युवाओं के भीतर सेवा अनुशासन नेतृत्व सहयोग और राष्ट्रप्रेम की भावना विकसित करने का एक प्रभावी माध्यम है।

विद्यार्थी जब समाज सेवा से जुड़ते हैं तब वे अनेक ऐसी बातें स्वतः सीखने लगते हैं जो उनके व्यक्तित्व को निरंतर निखारती रहती हैं। मंच के माध्यम से अपनी बात प्रभावी ढंग से प्रस्तुत करना समाज में जागरूकता फैलाना समूह में मिलकर कार्य करना छोटी-छोटी जिम्मेदारियों को व्यवस्थित ढंग से निभाना तथा समाज के प्रति संवेदनशील बनना – ये सभी गुण NSS के माध्यम से विकसित होते हैं। NSS स्वयं अच्छे कार्य करने के साथ-साथ दूसरों को भी सकारात्मक कार्यों के लिए प्रेरित करता है।

भारत विविधताओं से भरा हुआ एक विशाल राष्ट्र है। कहीं ऊँचे पर्वत हैं कहीं पठार कहीं घाटियाँ तो कहीं घने जंगल। विभिन्न क्षेत्रों की भाषा वेशभूषा संस्कृति और जीवनशैली अलग-अलग होने के बावजूद भारतीय समाज “एकता में अनेकता” की अद्भुत मिसाल प्रस्तुत करता है। ऐसे विशाल देश में प्रत्येक स्थान पर शासन-प्रशासन द्वारा हर कार्य को समय पर पूरा कर पाना सदैव संभव नहीं होता। ऐसी परिस्थितियों में NSS स्थानीय स्तर पर जनसहभागिता और श्रमदान के माध्यम से समाजोपयोगी कार्यों को सफलतापूर्वक संपन्न करने की प्रेरणा देता है। यदि सेवा और सहयोग की यही भावना प्रत्येक नागरिक के भीतर विकसित हो जाए तो भारत शीघ्र ही एक विकसित राष्ट्र के रूप में स्थापित हो सकता है।

चौकसे इंजीनियरिंग कॉलेज में विद्यार्थियों के सर्वांगीण विकास को ध्यान में रखते हुए वर्ष 2005 में NSS इकाई की स्थापना की गई। उस समय यह बिलासपुर संभाग का पहला ऐसा इंजीनियरिंग कॉलेज था जहाँ विद्यार्थियों के हित एवं व्यक्तित्व विकास के उद्देश्य से राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना इकाई प्रारंभ की गई थी।
